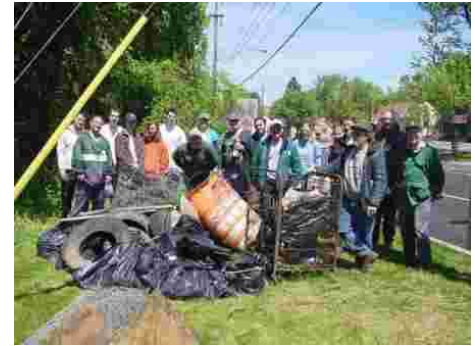


**Meet at the Gazebo/Pavilion on Coe Lake
