### Registration Guidelines

- 1. Registration Waivers** - must be completed upon registration. Minors under 18 years of age **MUST HAVE A PARENT'S SIGNATURE.**
- 2. Payment** - The proper payment must be made in cash, check or credit card at the time of registration.
- 3. No Refunds** - Individual program registration fees will only be refunded when a program is cancelled for insufficient registration or for a valid medical reason. A doctor's note will be required. Refunds may be prorated with an additional \$2.00 processing fee assessed.
- 4. Resident Passes** - Resident discount rates are only provided to those residents presenting a valid Resident Recreation Card.
- 5. Late Fees** - A fee of \$10.00 - \$15.00 will be assessed for some late registrations. (Please note the various program deadlines.)
- 6. Non-Residents** - Non-residents may register for any program. All facilities, including the Recreation Center, are available to the non-resident user.

### Resident Recreation Card Policies

All North Olmsted Residents are required to present a VALIDATED RESIDENT RECREATION CARD in order to receive the discounted resident rate. All Non-Cardholders and Non-Card Carriers will be charged the full registration fees.

To obtain a Resident Recreation Card, you must show PROOF OF RESIDENCE in the form of a current utility bill or tax statement.

The cost of the identification card, which includes your picture, is \$1.00 for each family member. If lost or misplaced, the fee for a replacement Resident Card is \$1.00. Once purchased, the Resident Recreation Card is valid for 1 year.

Please be sure to notify the Recreation Center of any change of address or phone number for records purposes.

All participants age six and over must have their own Resident Recreation Card. Children under age five registering for programs may use their parent's card.

Again, residents must present a current validated Resident Recreation Card to receive a resident rate on any programs or facility fees.
