

VICTIM'S RIGHTS

You should be aware that as a victim of crime you have a number of important rights including:

1. To be informed about what is occurring in your case;
2. To know the file number of your case;
3. To know the date and time of any proceedings;
4. To be present in court at any proceeding related to your case;
5. To know the name of the Defendant;
6. To know the procedures in place if you are subject to threats or intimidation by the Defendant or any other person;
7. To know of witness victim's advocacy services available;
8. To notify the Prosecutor in writing of any injuries you have suffered;
9. To know if the Defendant has been released from custody;
10. To be contacted before a plea; and
11. To make a statement at the Defendant's sentencing.
