**Mission statement:** The Oxcart Pantry is committed to providing healthy food assistance to residents of North Olmsted experiencing emergent need. The Oxcart Pantry provides food goods and household items to ease the burden of economic difficulties or catastrophic events which may be affecting individuals and families in North Olmsted. It is designed to supplement households and to provide added support for them to use their personal resources more effectively and eventually become self sufficient.

## **Welcome to the Oxcart Pantry!**

Tucked in the historic district of Butternut Ridge, the Oxcart Pantry opened its newly renovated location in June 2011. The facility is comfortable and spacious and is easily accessible to our residents. The pantry is stocked with non-perishable foods, frozen and refrigerated goods and household products which are donated through the generosity of individuals, schools, community organizations, businesses and churches. St. Richard Church is

our sponsor with the Greater Cleveland Food Bank which enables us to purchase additional food and goods at 'pennies on the pound' with any financial donations.

### **How to Access Assistance**

The Oxcart Pantry is conveniently located at 26272 Butternut Ridge Road in North Olmsted. It is immediately west of the I480 overpass on the north side of the road. Parking is available in the rear of the pantry in our park like setting.

only to help ensure individualized  
attention and confidentiality.**

Individuals and/or families qualified for assistance will be eligible to receive assistance once monthly in 30 day increments. Applications are renewed on a regular basis. A professional case manager will assist you. A holiday distribution near the end of the calendar year is included in this eligibility and it is our hope to include some 'extras' in assisting families during this time of year as resources permit.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- ✓ Persons must be a resident of the City of North Olmsted.
- ✓ Persons must meet certain income guidelines.
- ✓ There are no restrictions based upon age, creed, nationality or gender.
- ✓ Assistance is limited to one application per household.

The following documents are necessary to complete an application for assistance:

Proof of Residency: Current local utility billing statement showing name and address

Proof of Income: 3 recent paystubs from employer for all adults living in the household

Proof of Public Assistance: Social Security/Disability reward letters, WIC ID, Ohio Directions/Food Program ID, and/or Ohio Works First ID

Photo ID: Driver's License or State ID

The North Olmsted Oxcart Pantry uses income tables reflecting 200% of poverty according to Federal guidelines.


#### **Oxcart Pantry Wish List**
