## Other Programs

### Kids Computer Programming using Scratch level 1

Give your kids a head start by learning how to code. Computer programming skill promotes logical and analytical thinking. Scratch is a kids programming platform developed by MIT geared towards early childhood. It is used extensively worldwide to introduce computer programming to kids. All relevant concepts of programming language can be demonstrated in Scratch in very kid-like friendly environment. Almost everything is drag n drop and it can be used to produce very sophisticated programs. Scratch will build the interest in kids and the transition to other programming language will be seamlessly. No prior knowledge of computer programming required. However, kids should know how to use the mouse to navigate around the computer screen. Laptops will be provided to each kid, no sharing of computer. Kids will complete at least 3 mini games with each successive game consists of additional complexity. Kids will also learn limited computer terminology. Parents are encouraged to observe the class the entire time.
