

Curbside Recycling Weekly Collection

Place these items loose, not bagged in your Green Cart

- PAPER: cardboard boxes, newspapers, junk mail, magazines, cereal boxes, phone books, etc.
- Cans food & beverage cans; no scrap metal
- GLASS: food & beverages containers only
- PLASTICS: food, beverage, detergent & soap
- CARTONS: milk, juice, bottles, jugs, etc.

Please rinse food & beverage containers first!

Household Hazardous Waste >>>

Unused or leftover portion of any hazardous chemicals or materials labeled with danger, warning, toxic, caution, poison, flammable, corrosive, or reactive

Collection Dates

Spring April 11th – April 24th

Summer July 4th – July 17th

Fall September 5th- September 18th

Winter December 5th – December 18th

Drop Off Location: Fleet Garage at City Hall

Tire Disposal >>>

North Olmsted Residents can dispose of old scrap tires at City Hall's Fleet Garage during normal business hours in the month of **SEPTEMBER**

Year Round Collections >>>

- Used Computer Equipment
- Paper & Cardboard
- Used Oil
- Glass & Plastics
- Aluminum cans & metals

Yard Waste Program >>>

April 11th through December 1st, 2016

- All grass clippings & other yard waste should be placed in brown bags or in a can marked YARD WASTE, not to exceed 50 pounds
- Brush & small trimmings must be cut, bundled & securely tied not exceeding 50 pounds
- Republic Services will pick up on your normal garbage collection day
- Stop by Service Dept. for your complimentary yard waste bags: Mon-Fri: 8a.m. – 4p.m. First come, first serve, while supplies last. 10 bags per household.

Curbside Brush Chipping >>>

Weeks of April 25th through September 19th, 2016

- Brush must be piled on the tree lawn in a neat & orderly way with the cut ends pointing the same direction. Keep branches as long as possible
- Maximum branch diameter 8 inches. Large piles OR wood larger than 8 inches will be picked up at a later date
- Brush will be picked up by WARD by the Service Department

Bulk Pick Up Schedule >>>

First Full Business Week of the Month

- Bulk waste includes oversized items such as home furnishing, mattresses and box springs, carpet, appliances, and other household items too large to fit in your refuse containers
- Three 32 gallon cans or up to 6 bags of trash
- Carpet must be tied and rolled in 4' lengths
- Washer, Dryers & Refrigerators - doors must be removed
- Toilets: separate tank from bowl
