2016 COLLECTION PROGRAMS

Household Hazardous Waste Round Up

Spring: April 11- April 24

Fall: September 5 - September 18

Summer: July 4 - July 17

Winter: December 5 - December 18

Drop off location: Service Yard / Fleet Garage at 5200 Dover Center Road

Items collected:

Oil or solvent-based paint (aerosols or liquids)

Paint thinner, mineral spirits, turpentine

Pesticides, herbicides, fungicides

Pool chemicals

Adhesives, roof tar, driveway sealer

Mercury

Sealers, primers, or coatings (aerosols or liquids)

Varnishes, polyurethanes, shellacs

Caustic household cleaners

Automotive fluids, motor oil, car batteries

Kerosene, gasoline, lighter fluid

Fluorescent bulbs

Do not drop off Latex paint

Latex paint is comprised mostly of water and is not a hazardous material to dispose of. You can dry out latex paint by removing the lid. Once it has solidified place it in your curbside trash

Used Oil

Year Round

Drop off location: Fleet Garage at 5200 Dover Center Road

Items collected: Any type of liquid waste oil in a sealed container will be taken year round

Computer Round Up

Year Round Drop off location: Service Yard / Fleet Garage at 5200 Dover Center Road

Items collected: CPU's, monitors, keyboards, software, mice, printers, terminals, modems, ink jet cartridges, cell phones, etc.

Scrap Tire Round Up

September 1 through September 30

Drop off location: Service Yard / Fleet Garage at 5200 Dover Center Road

Items collected: Used tires without rims only.

**You can dispose of your old tires through your tire retailer at the time of purchase of new tires.

Paper and Cardboard Container Recycling

Year Round

Drop off location: Cardboard/Paper Dumpster at 5200 Dover Center Road

Items collected: Paper, cardboard, junk mail, phone books, newspaper, magazines and shoeboxes. No food packing/containers or pizza boxes

Appliance (Freon) Curbside Collection

Year Round

Put out during BULK week, doors off.

Items collected: Any appliance containing Freon; refrigerators, freezers, air conditioning units, dehumidifiers, etc.

Phone Book Recycling Campaign

Drop off location: 5200 Dover Center Road

Cardboard/Paper Dumpster year round

Phone Book Recycling Campaign

June 1 through September 30
