



COVID-19 Temporary Signs in Nonresidential Districts Policy

In order to assist in facilitating our businesses in notifying the public of operations during the current pandemic, the following COVID-19 Temporary Signs in Nonresidential Districts Policy shall be effective immediately and remain in effect until December 31, 2021.

- (a) The requirement for an application or permit is waived.
- (b) Signs shall be permitted until December 31, 2021.
- (c) Nonresidential districts will be permitted the following temporary signage in addition to signage currently permitted in Section 1163.13 (Temporary Sign Allowances):
 - 1. Maximum number: two (2) per business unit
 - 2. Maximum area per sign: twenty (20) square feet
 - 3. Maximum height: six (6) feet
 - 4. Types permitted: Yard, Banner, Window
