- 2020-98 An Ordinance amending Section 1345.05 of Chapter 1345 of the Building Code entitled “Standards for Private Residential Pools” to incorporate standards established by the International Code Council for Pools, Spas and Hot Tubs installed at residential properties.
- 2020-99 An Ordinance amending and reestablishing Section 1359.09 of Chapter 1359 of the Building Code entitled “Maintenance of Unoccupied Commercial Buildings” in order to establish the appeal process from an order of the Building Commissioner.
- 2020-100 An Ordinance amending the Traffic Control File of the City of North Olmsted to remove the no parking signs on Charles Road.

- 2020-101 An Ordinance to make and transfer appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures for the City of North Olmsted for the year ending December 31, 2020 and declaring an emergency, as amended.
- 2020-102 A Resolution directing the Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County to pay to the City of North Olmsted, Ohio, during the year 2021 all money due and owing said city from any collection source.
- 2020-103 An Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$1,415,000 of notes, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to provide funds to pay part of the City’s portion of the costs of improving Brookpark Road between certain termini, in cooperation with the Department of Transportation of the State of Ohio, by grading, draining, curbing, reconstructing and rehabilitating the pavement base, and adjusting, constructing and reconstructing catch basins, curbs and curb ramps, manholes and utility valve and monument boxes, where necessary, preparing the surface and resurfacing and providing

decorative lighting and landscaping, in each case together with necessary appurtenances and work incidental thereto.

- 2020-104 A Resolution authorizing the Mayor or Director of Public Service to advertise for bids for the award of a contract to purchase concrete materials and related supplies for the year 2021, as detailed in the specifications on file with the Engineer, and authorizing the Mayor, following approval of the Board of Control, to contract for the same with the lowest and best bidder.
- 2020-105 A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to purchase computer products, including desktops, from CDW Government, LLC at a cost of \$47,886.55 through the State Purchase Program; and further authorizing the Mayor to execute all documents necessary to effectuate such purchase, and declaring an emergency.
- 2020-106 An Ordinance amending and re-establishing Chapter 167.99 of the Administrative Code, entitled "Composition and Organization of the Department of Human Resources" in order to implement organization changes within the department and to create the new position of "Building Department Coordinator", and declaring an emergency, as amended.
- 2020-107 An Ordinance to establish the positions of Division of Building Coordinator full time and part time and corresponding compensation for each; and otherwise restate the compensation rates and descriptions for various administrative and legislative personnel for the years 2018, 2019 and 2020, and declaring an emergency.

- 2020-108 A Resolution to accept a donation of patio pavers and furniture from the Mayor, Kevin M. Kennedy, for use by the City of North Olmsted.
- 2020-109 An Ordinance amending and reestablishing Section 161.01 of Chapter 161 of the Administrative Code entitled "Non-Bargaining Unit Employee Benefits" in order to adjust funeral leave benefits.
- 2020-110 A Resolution approving of and authorizing the Mayor to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement with Ohio Council 8, Local 2681, of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees ("AFSCME"), AFL-CIO, for the city's service workers, for the period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2023.
- 2020-111 A Resolution authorizing and directing the Director of Planning & Community Development to make application to the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) on behalf of the City of North Olmsted for funding for safety related improvements to Clague Road; and further authorizing funds for the required local match; and further authorizing the Mayor to accept the grant if awarded and to execute a contract for the same, and declaring an emergency.
