An Ordinance amending and reestablishing Section 161.01 of Chapter 161 of the Administrative Code entitled “Non-Bargaining Unit Employee Benefits” in order to adjust funeral leave benefits, as amended.
- 2020-110 A Resolution approving of and authorizing the Mayor to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement with Ohio Council 8, Local 2681, of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (“AFSCME”), AFL-CIO, for the city’s service workers, for the period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2023.
- 2020-78 Second Reading
An Ordinance providing for the amendment of Chapter 1115 (Definitions) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Olmsted, as amended.
- 2020-79 An Ordinance providing for the replacement of Chapter 1163 (Signs) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Olmsted, as amended.
- 2020-112 An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Finance to request proposals from certified public accountants to provide GAAP conversion assistance services for the preparation of the 2020 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR); and further authorizing the Mayor, subject to approval of the Board of Control, to enter into a five (5) year agreement (with a two (2) year option) with the professional selected in the RFP process, and declaring an emergency.

- 2020-114 A Resolution approving of and authorizing the Mayor to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement (“CBA”) with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (“AFSCME”) Local 2681, Clerical & Technical Unit, for the period of January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2023, and declaring an emergency.
- 2020-115 A Resolution authorizing the Director of Human Resources to solicit proposals pursuant to the request for proposal process (“RFP”) for the lease and servicing of photocopiers, and further authorizing the Mayor, subject to approval of the Board of Control, to enter into a contract for same.
- 2020-116 An Ordinance amending Section 131.06 entitled, “Authority to Accept Donations” of Chapter 131 of the Administrative Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Olmsted entitled “Mayor” in order to revise standards for the acceptance of donations to the City of North Olmsted.
- 2020-117 An Ordinance amending Section 555.09 “Emergency Exception” of Chapter 555 “Noise Control” of the General Offenses Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Olmsted to include emergency generators as an exception to the Noise Control Standards, and declaring an emergency.
- 2020-118 A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to renew the contract between the City and Karrie Skall Tipton/North Olmsted Gymnastics, Inc. for the provision of professional gymnastics instruction services at the North Olmsted Recreation Center for an additional six month term with option to extend for full one (1) year.
- 2020-119 A Resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Olmsted to enter into a one-year agreement with Reit Vending LLC in order to provide for vending machine services at the North Olmsted Recreation Center.
- 2020-120 A Resolution authorizing the Director of Planning and Community Development to make application on behalf of the City of North Olmsted for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the fiscal year 2021 for the Elm Road Rehabilitation Project; further authorizing the Mayor to accept grand funds, if awarded, and to execute contract with Cuyahoga County if required; and declaring an emergency.
- 2020-121 An Ordinance dispensing with the formal RFP process and authorizing and directing the Director of Planning and Community Development to engage the services of Mott MacDonald to undertake a Road Safety Audit for portions of Berkshire Road and Porter Road for the purpose of investigating safety concerns presented to the Council by the public and to make recommendations for roadway safety improvements, and declaring an emergency.
