LEGISLATION:

- 2020-111 Second Reading
A Resolution authorizing and directing the Director of Planning and Community Development to make application to the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) on behalf of the City of North Olmsted for funding for safety related improvements to Clague Road; and further authorizing funds for the required local match; and further authorizing the Mayor to accept the grant if awarded and to execute a contract for the same, and declaring an emergency, as amended.
- 2021-55 A Resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Fiscal Officer.
- 2021-56 A Resolution authorizing the Director of Planning & Community Development to advertise for bids to award a contract to provide construction services for the Clague Park Restroom and Walking Path Project, as detailed in the specifications on file in the Division of Engineering, and authorizing the Mayor, following approval of the Board of Control, to enter a contract with the lowest and best bidder.
- 2021-57 An Ordinance amending and re-establishing Section 505.16 entitled “Vicious and Dangerous Animals” of Chapter Five of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Olmsted in order to adopt and follow State code procedures for determinations by the Animal Control Officer and to provide for judicial hearings of appeals, and declaring an emergency.

2021-58 An Ordinance to amend Section 555.03 entitled “Specific Prohibitions” of Chapter 555 of the General Offenses Code entitled “Noise Control” of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Olmsted for the purpose of modifying special regulations for specific activities occurring on Sunday’s including, but not limited to, lawn mowing.

First Reading

2021-59 A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to advertise for bids for the award of a contract to purchase concrete materials and related supplies for the year 2022, as detailed in the specifications on file with the Engineer, and authorizing the Mayor, following approval of the Board of Control, to contract for the same with the lowest and best bidder.

2021-60 A Resolution authorizing the Senior Center Administrator to make application to the Western Reserve Area Agency on Aging (“WRAAA”) for a Title IIIC Nutrition Grant for 2022 and 2023 and, if awarded, further authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the WRAAA to accept the grant funds, and declaring an emergency.

2021-61 A Resolution extending the Temporary Outdoor Patio Dining Area Program until December 31, 2021, and declaring an emergency.
