LEGISLATION:

Third Reading

- 2022-93 An Ordinance establishing and fixing the compensation for Council-At-Large Members for the term of office commencing January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2027.
- 2022-95 An Ordinance amending and re-establishing Section 141.99(d) of the Administrative Code entitled “Composition and Organization of the Department of Public Service” in order to create the position of “Pretreatment Biosolids Coordinator” and to amend the organizational chart accordingly.
- 2022-96 A Resolution authorizing the Director of Public Service to advertise for bids to award a contract for construction of the Sanitary Sewer South Interceptor Flow Equalization Tank project, as detailed in the specifications on file with the City Engineer; and further authorizing the Mayor, following approval of the Board of Control, to contract for the same with the lowest and best bidder.

Consulting for Reduction of City Energy Consumption and Utility Costs; further authorizing the Mayor, subject to approval of the Board of Control, to enter into an agreement with the firm selected in the RFP process), and declaring an emergency.

- 2022-115 An Ordinance Amending the Rates of Compensation for Administrative Personnel to add a Building Commissioner and Part-Time Master Plans Examiner for the years 2022 and 2023; and otherwise restating the compensation rates and descriptions for various administrative and legislative personnel for the years 2022 and 2023, and declaring an emergency.
- 2022-116 An Ordinance establishing new and revised Program Fee Ranges for use of Park and Recreation Facilities, and further restating said program fees, and declaring an emergency.
- 2022-117 A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Poolside Adventures to install an aquatic climbing wall at the Recreation Center, and declaring an emergency.
- 2022-118 An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Safety to contract for and proceed with demolition and removal of unsafe structures located at 28757 Oring Drive, in the City of North Olmsted, as a public nuisance, and further directing that abatement costs be Certified as a lien upon said parcel, pursuant to R.C. 715.261, and declaring an emergency.
