\*Property owners are responsible for maintenance of aprons, culvert pipes and curbing. **All culvert pipes and any deteriorated or broken curbing along the apron shall be replaced at the time of apron replacement.** Culvert replacement may only be waived by the City Engineer upon submission to the city photo evidence of the culvert's acceptable condition and owner acknowledgement. The applicant is responsible for any excavation required to inspect the culvert pipe. An inlet shall be installed with new culvert pipes longer than 40 ft. to facilitate future drainage, inspection and maintenance.

EXCAVATIONS AGREEMENT: The party performing the work, whether contractor or homeowner, agrees and will do the following: When excavated site is not attended, barricades and/or caution tape shall be placed around all sides of excavated work. This safety barrier shall be placed as per reasonable practice so as to protect pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists from the hazards of open excavations.

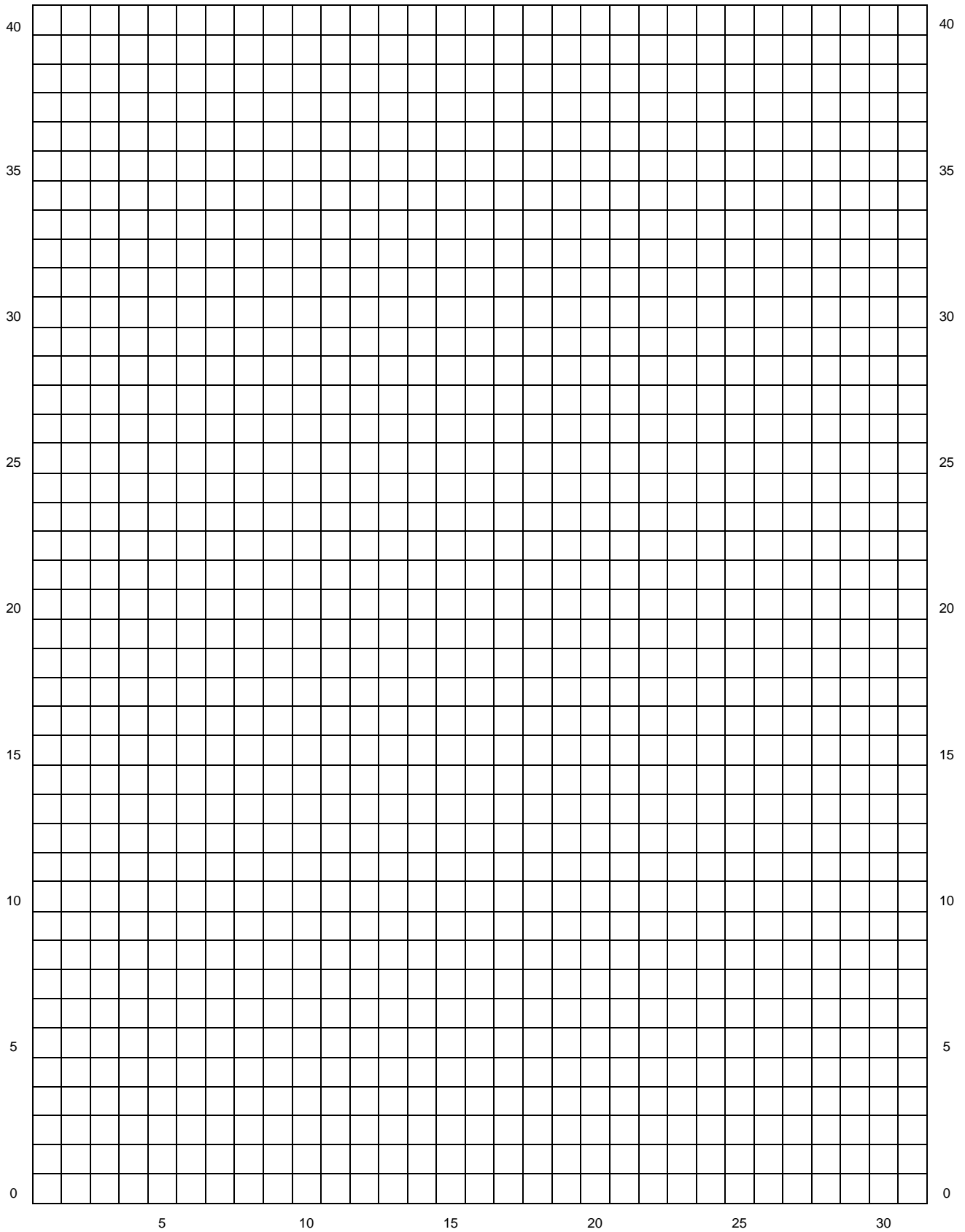
### ③ Acknowledgment

The acceptance of a permit shall constitute an agreement on the applicant's part to abide by all the conditions of approval, and to comply with all ordinances of the City of North Olmsted and the laws of the State of Ohio relating to the work to be done. **The applicant is responsible for code compliance and liability for any damages by the contractor or subcontractor in his employ. Any contractor/subcontractor working in the City of North Olmsted must be registered with the Division of Building.**

**The undersigned agrees to notify the Division of Building AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE of backfilling, pouring pavement or as otherwise required by the city to schedule required inspections.**
