SNOW EMERGENCIES

When snowfall accumulations are 2" or more, a snow storm emergency may be declared. **When a snow emergency is declared, parking on all City streets is prohibited.** Snow storm emergency notifications will be placed on the City's website and will be provided to local media outlets.

Mailbox Durability

A common misconception about mailbox damage is that the plow on the truck comes into direct contact with the mailbox. Actually, most mailboxes are damaged by the heavy snow as it is pushed to the side of the road by the plow. The Service Department suggests that residents check to make sure that their mailbox is not deteriorating or in poor condition.



Mailboxes in poor condition will not be as durable in the harsh Ohio winters as mailboxes that are in good condition. The Service Department will only replace mailboxes if they are struck by our equipment, not ones that are knocked over by snow during our street cleaning duties.

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

Starting January 1, 2020, the ENTIRE City of North Olmsted will be going back to same day, once a month BULK collection. Information in the mail to follow from Republic Services. Bulk collection dates for 2020 are as follows:

January 9th	July 9th
February 6th	August 6th
March 5th	September 11th
April 9th	October 8th
May 7th	November 5th
June 4th	December 10th

Bulk Pick Up: February 6th for EVERYONE

REPUBLIC SERVICES YARD WASTE COLLECTION:

No current collection going on. Put in garbage can (not recycle) OR plastic bags ONLY December – March on Bulk collection day. April 2, 2020 will be the first collection of next year.

CITY CURBSIDE BRUSH CHIPPING:

The chipping schedule has changed for the 2020 year. We are starting the Spring/Summer/Fall schedule a week earlier and adding another rotation through the wards.

****We have also added a city-wide sweep once a month during October – March that will start the first Monday of every month.**** Same rules apply: Must be out by 7:00 AM. There will be text messages reminders sent on the Friday before the Monday the brush is due out.

North Olmsted Recreation Center Ice Rink Rehabilitation



The ice rink at the North Olmsted Recreation Center is getting an overhaul in 2020. The rink will be shut down after the Ice Show in May until Labor Day so construction work can take place. Our patrons will be excited with the upcoming changes! While the configuration of the ice will remain unchanged (main rink plus studio rink), many improvements are in store, which will improve the experience for our skaters and spectators alike.

- Replacement of the sand floor system, as well as the dasher boards at both rinks including the glass, doors and player boxes;
- Removal of existing bag insulation and installation of a new metal building insulation system and ceiling;
- Installation of a new fixed storefront glass wall system to separate the rink area from the warming area;
- Renovation of the warming area including replacement of the flooring system in the warming area and adjacent restrooms and team rooms along with complete repainting of the ice arena;
- Reconfiguration of the concession area with a new folding partition to allow separation into smaller spaces;
- Reconditioning of the existing dehumidification unit and installation of new HVAC units and ductwork; and
- Addressing the problematic issues on the roof by removing parapet fascia, making necessary repairs to remaining support structures and installing new flashing.

The total project cost is estimated at \$2,165,000. The city is borrowing these funds for repayment using our existing financial resources. No new taxes will be assessed to cover the cost of this investment in our rink.

We are working hard to update and upgrade our recreation facilities to preserve the ice skating legacy in North Olmsted. We look forward to unveiling our new and improved ice rink to the community this fall.
