### **REPUBLIC SERVICES YARD WASTE COLLECTION:**

No current collection going on. Put in garbage can (not recycle) OR plastic bags should be used December – March and put out on Bulk collection day.

April 2, 2020 will be the first collection of next year.

### **CITY CURBSIDE BRUSH CHIPPING:**
