

## Household Hazardous Waste Collection >>>

Unused or leftover portion of any hazardous chemicals or materials labeled with danger, warning, toxic, caution, poison, flammable, corrosive, or reactive

### Collection Dates

Spring: April 8 – April 21

Summer: July 1 – July 14

Fall: September 2 - September 15

Winter: December 2 – December 15

**Drop Off Location: Behind City Hall at Fleet Garage**

## Year Round Collections >>>

- Used Computer Equipment
- Paper & Cardboard (see below)
- Used Oil & Gasoline
- Glass & Plastics (LOOSE or CLEAR BAGS ONLY)
- Aluminum Cans & Metals (LOOSE or CLEAR BAGS ONLY)

**Drop off location: Behind City Hall at Fleet Garage**

## River Valley Paper Company Recycling Program >>>

Paper & Cardboard Dumpsters located behind City Hall, next to gas pumps.

Acceptable Items (place items LOOSE in dumpsters)

Magazines, Catalogs, Newspapers, Junk Mail, Hard & Soft Bound Books, Coupons, Phonebooks, Shredded Paper (in bags), Cardboard (broken-down)

## Yard Waste Collection Program >>>

Collection by Republic Services: 440-458-3216

April 11<sup>th</sup> through November 29<sup>th</sup>

- Pick up day: THURSDAY
- All grass clippings & other yard waste should be placed in brown bags or in a can marked YARD WASTE, not to exceed 50 pounds
- Brush & small trimmings must be cut to 4ft lengths or less, bundled & securely tied, not to exceed 50 pounds
- Beginning April 1<sup>st</sup>: Stop by Service Dept. or City Hall front desk for complimentary yard waste bags: Mon-Fri: 9a.m. – 4p.m. First come, first serve, while supplies last.  
**1 pick-up per household per year**

## City Curbside Brush Chipping Program >>>

**First City-Wide Pass:** Week of April 22<sup>nd</sup>

**City-Wide Pass:** Week of September 16<sup>th</sup>

**Last City-Wide Pass:** Week of November 4<sup>th</sup>

- MUST be out by 7a.m. on Monday
- Brush will be picked up by WARD weekly
- Brush must be piled on the tree lawn in a neat & orderly way with the cut ends pointing the same direction. Keep branches as long as possible
- Large piles, root-balls or branches larger than 8 inches in diameter will be picked up at a later date that week or the following week
- We do not accept lumber, landscape ties, etc.

**ONCE a month per residence**

- Republic Services picks up on Thursdays
- Up to three 32 gallon cans or 6 bags of trash
- Bulk waste includes oversized items such as home furnishings, mattresses (wrapped in plastic & sealed w/heavy duty tape), TV's, box springs, appliances & other items too large to fit in your refuse containers
- Carpet, Wood of any kind & Boxes must be 4' lengths or less, tied/bundled, 40lbs or less
- Appliances:
  - \*doors must be removed
  - \*freon must be removed & unit tagged
- Toilets: separate tank from bowl

## Delayed Garbage Pick-Up Schedule >>>

ALL PICK-UPS DELAYED ONE DAY

New Year's Day:	Jan. 3 to Jan. 4
Memorial Day:	May 30 to May 31
Independence Day:	July 4 to July 5
Labor Day:	Sept. 5 to Sept. 6
Thanksgiving Day:	Nov. 28 to Nov. 29
Christmas Day:	Dec. 26 to Dec. 27

## Christmas Tree Disposal >>>

- Live, undecorated trees are collected the **2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> collection days** of the year.
- Artificial, bagged or decorated trees **ONLY** disposed of on **bulk** pick up day.

April 13<sup>th</sup> and October 12<sup>th</sup>  
9am – Noon  
LOCATION: Rec Center  
2 bags/boxes per N.O. resident
