NORTH OLMSTED, OH – Back by popular demand, fireworks return to North Olmsted in 2017 on Sunday, July 2nd in celebration of Independence Day weekend.

The entire community is invited to the fireworks watch party to be held at Great Northern Mall starting at 7:00pm. The parking lot area south of the mall's ring road and Country Club Boulevard between Great Northern Boulevard and the Dillard's entrance will become a pedestrian-only space where families can set up their lawn chairs and enjoy the pre-fireworks festivities.

Activities will include a variety of food trucks, a Family Zone featuring games, balloon benders, face painters, jugglers, magicians and more. Music will be provided by DJ Gaz. Food vendors include Manna Food Truck, Barrio, East Coast Custard, Sugar High!, Fire Truck Pizza Co., Wilbeck's BBQ, Premier Crepes, Fired Up Taco Truck, Stone Pelican Rolling Café and City Grow Green Machine.

Fireworks are set to launch at dusk. Guests arriving by car are advised to arrive early as crowds are expected and traffic patterns around the mall will change. Country Club Boulevard at Great Northern Boulevard will be closed starting at 6:00pm.
