

Welcome to the North Olmsted Oxcart Pantry!

Mission statement: The mission of the North Olmsted Oxcart Pantry is to provide food assistance to families and individuals residing in North Olmsted who are currently experiencing need. The Oxcart Pantry provides food and household items to ease the burden of economic difficulties or catastrophic events affecting individuals and families in our community. It is designed to be a supplemental source of food and household goods to provide added support for these residents to better utilize their personal resources more effectively.



How to Access Assistance

To access the Oxcart Pantry you may call for an appointment to complete an application for assistance. We are open Tuesdays 8-4pm Wednesdays 8:30-6pm and Thursdays 8-4pm.

To better serve you...All services are by appointment only.

Individuals and families qualified for assistance will be eligible to receive assistance every 30 days. Appointments are scheduled for Wednesday pick-up times typically scheduled in 10 minute intervals. Some exceptions to regular schedules are made during the holiday season and will be posted with our extended hours.



Nutrition is important to us! We strive to have fresh produce on hand whenever possible along with healthier choices like low fat milk, wheat pasta and brown rice. We know that health related problems can often be improved with good nutrition. If you are unfamiliar with some products, just ask us for recipes, our staff will be glad to assist!

Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ Persons must be an established resident (homeowner or renter with a lease agreement) of the City of North Olmsted.
- ✓ Persons must meet certain income guidelines (Federal Guidelines 200% poverty).
- ✓ There are no restrictions based upon age, religion, nationality, gender or sexual orientation.
- ✓ Assistance is limited to one application per household.

The following documents are necessary to complete an application for assistance:

Proof of Residency: Current local utility billing statement showing name and address

Proof of Income: 3 recent paystubs from employer for all adults living in the household

Proof of Public Assistance: Social Security/Disability reward letters, WIC ID, Ohio Directions/SNAP ID, or Ohio Works First ID

Photo ID: Driver's License or State ID

The North Olmsted Oxcart Pantry uses income tables reflecting 200% of poverty according to Federal guidelines.

If you or your organization would like to help our pantry with donations please contact us to coordinate needs, dates and deliveries. We can accept non-perishable boxed, jars or canned goods along with financial donations.

1. Boxed or canned full meals such as pasta, stews, kits

10. Laundry detergent


