

## LEGAL ADVERTISEMENT

Sealed bids will be received by the Director of Planning of the City of North Olmsted until 11:30 a.m. on **November 10, 2021**, for **Clague Park Restroom & Walking Path Project**, in accordance with Resolution No. 2021-56, and in accordance with plans and specifications on file in the Engineering Dept. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope and clearly marked with the Bid Resolution Number, opening date and item being bid. Each bid must state the full name and address of each person, firm or corporation interested in the bid. Bids must be delivered directly to North Olmsted City Hall, 5200 Dover Center Rd, North Olmsted, Ohio, 44070, prior to 11:30 a.m. of the day of the bid opening.

**Bidders must be a planholder of record with the City in order for their bid to be considered.** Bids must be submitted on the forms available in the Building Dept. at North Olmsted City Hall. Copies of the specifications, bid forms, drawings and other contract documents may be obtained in person during business hours upon depositing a check for twenty dollars (\$20), made payable to the CITY OF NORTH OLMSTED. The deposit(s) will be non-refundable. No plans or specifications will be mailed. Questions regarding the bid shall be directed in writing to the Engineering Dept.

An optional pre-bid meeting will be held online on October 27, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. The meeting link is also available on city website: <https://global.gotomeeting.com/join/408218613> or call (786) 535-3211 and enter access code 408-218-613.

Each bid for each project must be accompanied by a certified check on a solvent bank in the amount of 10% of the bid or a 100% Bid Bond, the same being payable to the City of North Olmsted as a guarantee that, if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and a Performance Bond satisfactory to said municipality in an amount equal to 100% of the total bid will be furnished. The deposit of the successful bidder will be retained until the contract is executed and delivered. Deposits of all unsuccessful bidders will be returned following award.

The City reserves the right to accept all or any part of any bid and to reject any and all bids, and to waive any informality in the bids received, and to accept any bid, or combination of bids, which it deems lowest and best. The City of North Olmsted is an Equal Opportunity Employer and does not discriminate against the physically impaired. Each bidder must ensure that all employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, creed, color, sex or national origin.

State of Ohio Fund 7031 or 7035 monies are being used to assist construction and relevant state requirements apply. Bidders must comply with prevailing wage rates on public improvements in Cuyahoga County and the City of North Olmsted, Ohio as determined by the US Department of Labor. The estimated construction cost is \$177,135.

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
