ORDINANCE NO. 2022 - 99**

***AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO REQUEST PROPOSALS FOR PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT SURVEY, ANALYSIS, REPORTING AND DATA HOSTING FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF CONTROL, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FIRM SELECTED IN THE RFP PROCESS.***

***WHEREAS***, it is the recommendation of the Mayor that this Council adopt and enable the City to improve planning for pavement management via survey, analysis, reporting and data hosting in order to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of public improvement of streets; and

***WHEREAS***, the Director of Economic and Community Development recommends that this Council authorize, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 111 of the North Olmsted Codified Ordinances, the initiation of an RFP process to select the most qualified firm to provide pavement management services; and

***WHEREAS***, it is the desire of this Council to so authorize requests for proposals from pavement management professionals and/or firms most qualified to serve as the City's professional consultant, providing services to the Director of Economic Development, Director of Public Service and / or City Engineer, and further to authorize the Mayor to enter into an Agreement with the firm selected in the RFP process upon approval by the Board of Control.

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH OLMSTED, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, AND STATE OF OHIO:***

**SECTION 1:** That the Director of Economic and Community Development be and he is hereby authorized to request proposals from firms qualified to serve as and provide pavement management and to provide professional consulting services to the Director of Economic and Community Development and Director of Public Service in accordance with the Request for Proposals. A copy of the said Request for Proposals is on file in the office of the Director of Economic and Community Development.

**SECTION 2:** That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized, upon approval of the Board of Control, to enter into an agreement or agreements with the firm selected in the RFP process. Said agreement shall be in the form approved by the Director of Law, with such additional modifications and changes in form or in substance that are not

substantially adverse to the City and which are approved by the Director of Law. The character of any such changes as not being substantially adverse to the City shall be evidenced conclusively by the execution of the agreement by the Mayor and the approval of the agreement by the Director of Law.

**SECTION 3:** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
