

Pavilion, Shelter, Gazebo and Park Reservations

Reserving a Pavilion, Shelter, Gazebo and Park Reservations must be done, in person, at North Olmsted Recreation Center prior to date of use. Reservations for the pavilions, shelters and gazebo can be made, beginning March 1st, for the upcoming season. The Parks and Pavilions Rental Agreement Form must be completed 14 days prior to the event. Individuals must be 21 years of age and older to make a reservation. Fees must be paid in full at the time of reservation. All park reservations must be requested through our Sports Program Supervisor, Colin Kilbane.

Cancellation of a Reservation North Olmsted Parks & Recreation Department has established that no refunds will be issued for any reservation of a pavilion, shelter or gazebo. In the event of extreme weather conditions or park closings, as determined by North Olmsted Parks and Recreation, every effort will be made to reschedule your event on dates that the pavilion has not already been rented or give a household credit which can be used for any other activity registered through the Recreation Department.

Paperwork Once your pavilion rental has been confirmed by the North Olmsted Parks and Recreation Department, the pavilion is yours to use for the rental date and times. You should bring a copy of your reservation form with you on the day of your event. If another party is using the pavilion when you arrive please show them your reservation form. If any problems occur the day of your rental, please contact the front desk of the Recreation Center at (440) 734-8200.

Entertainment The City of North Olmsted reserves the right to approve and/or disapprove any entertainment offered at an event. The type of entertainment must be provided to the North Olmsted Parks and Recreation Department at least 30 days in advance of the event.

Parking Neither the Renter or any person attending or serving an event may park on public roads, grass or pedestrian paths without approval from North Olmsted Parks and Recreation Department.

Fields Use of fields is permitted only when no league games or practices are scheduled. Any organized game or athletic event on any field must have a permit that requires a fee. Fields must be left in good playing condition and may not be used when wet. A permit must be secured in order to use a field at night requiring lights.

Cleanup The renter is responsible for clean up at the pavilion. All garbage, including loose trash, should be placed in garbage cans. Signs/banners should be removed. Tape should be removed from beams and picnic tables. Additional garbage cans can be placed at the pavilion if requested 1 week prior to rental.
